## Safeguarding Statement

At St Joseph's Catholic Primary School we are committed to creating a safe environment for all pupils.

**Keeping Children Safe in Education** places the following responsibilities on all schools:

- Schools should be aware of and follow the procedures established by the Hertfordshire Safeguarding Children Board
- Staff should be alert to signs of abuse and know to whom they should report any concerns or suspicions
- Schools should have procedures (of which all staff are aware) for handling suspected cases of abuse of pupils, including procedures to be followed if a member of staff is accused of abuse, or suspected of abuse
- A Designated Senior Person/Lead has responsibility for co-ordinating action with the school and liaising with other agencies

A duty is placed upon **all** adults within our school to safeguard and promote the welfare of the children.

**Aims of Safeguarding Procedure and practice at St Joseph's Catholic Primary School:**

- To include child protection arrangements and staff code of conduct at staff inductions
- To ensure annual reviews of the **Child Protection policy** and its implementation
- To provide a safe school in which we actively promote the safety of every child, including safety online
- To provide a safe environment where children feel secure, are encouraged to express their feelings on matters relating to safety and are listened to when they have a worry or concern
- To ensure that the children know that there are adults in the school whom they can approach if they are worried
- To ensure that designated staff, including governors, receive appropriate training to enable effective oversight and monitoring of the safeguarding policy and procedure
- To provide regular Safeguarding training to all staff so that they are knowledgeable and aware of their role and of the appropriate procedures to follow
- To provide a message to all adults within our community, that we are a safe school
- To embed messages about Personal Safety, including eSafety into our curriculum
- To ensure newly appointed/elected governors attend relevant safeguarding training
